Use of cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to personalise and improve our websites. We only use cookies which are essential for the operation of our site and for security.

A cookie is an element of data that a website can send to your computer (or other electronic device), which may then store it on your system. Cookies allow us to understand who has seen which pages on our website and manages how different pages on our website interact with each other. Non-personal information such as browser type, operating system and domain names, may be collected during visitors' use of the website and this information may be used by us in the operation of our site.

Management of cookies

Consent to cookies not required

As we only use cookies which are essential for the operation of our site and for security, you will not be asked to give your consent to cookies being placed on your device when you visit our website.

Decline or Refuse Essential Cookies

If you wish to remove cookies placed on your device by our website you can do this at any time by setting your browser to remove or reject browser cookies. Please be aware that if you decline all cookies via your browser you may not be able to access parts of the website.

What types of cookies do we use?

We use cookies and similar tools across our website to enable our website to work and improve security.

These cookies are necessary for the Website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information. We also use essential cookies to maintain the security of our web sites and protect your information, by detecting and preventing cyber attacks.

Cookie domain:

The domain attribute specifies which hosts can receive a cookie. If a domain is set, then this also includes access to that cookie from any subdomain.

First party cookies:

We set these cookies and they can only be read by us. These are cookies created by the website and / or are used specifically for a feature on the website.

Third party cookies:

We may use a number of third-party suppliers who also set cookies on our website in order to deliver the services that they are providing. These cookies are known as third party cookies. We do not control the dissemination of these cookies and you should check the relevant third party's website for more information.

Persistent cookies:

We may use persistent cookies which will be saved on your computer for a fixed period. We have detailed in the table below the periods for which those cookies are held. They won't be deleted when the browser is closed. We may use persistent cookies to recognise your device for more than one browsing session. For example, persistent cookies allow us to save your password so that you do not have to re-enter it every time you visit our website. Our website may also use cookies to monitor website traffic.

Session cookies:

We may use session cookies which are only stored temporarily during a browsing session and will be deleted from your device when the browser is closed.

Details and functions of the categories of cookies currently used on our website, including the cookie lifespan, are set out in the table below.
